Sessions guidance:

LEARN- learn and share experiences from around the world about important issues for people with intellectual disabilities and their families. Session Format: 'How-To' style workshops on global standards for inclusive practice.

Personal Stories- inspire and be inspired by sharing personal success stories of working for inclusive policy, programs, and practices. Session Format will be TEDex style sessions where self-advocates, parents, service providers, or policy experts may share their experiences.





LEAD- lead the way as a global movement in promoting inclusive communities for all. Present new approaches, tools, initiative or any new idea that promotes inclusion. Session Format: Discussions and presentations that answer the question: How are we going to move the global disability agenda forward?
