If you do not know who to contact, you can still apply, and the programme committee can put your session together with someone else's.


2 You **must** have at least one selfadvocate or family member speaking.



Your session **must** be about inclusion. Sessions that are about segregation or "special" activities will not be accepted.

What are the types of session?



There are three types of sessions at the World Congress:

1 Learn Sessions: These sessions will teach people about a good way of working. It will be like a "how-to "session.




2 Engage Sessions: These are small sessions where the people in the room will work together. Everyone in the room will talk and take part in the activity.



Impact Sessions: These sessions will be about the different ways to solve big issues. There will be a few speakers, and they will all share stories and examples of what they did to solve a problem in their country.
